Symposium Registration:

The symposium registration numbers were 1015, final number of participants was 985, and the number of accompanying persons was 32. The participants came from 27 countries. The registration fee for active parti-

pants was ¥ 40,000, for the young scientists ¥15,000, and for the accompanying persons ¥10,000. Travel Trust Program of International Science Foundation (ISF) supported 9 chemists from foreign countries.

Scientific Session:

The scientific session includes 7 plenary lectures (45 min. + 5 min. discussion), 15 invited lectures (25 min. + 5 min. discussion), and 45 short lectures (12 min. + 2 min. discussion). The symposium was held at the main hall in one session except for the afternoon session on 20th (Monday), where parallel two sessions of short lectures were organized. The main hall was always full of participants; therefore, a 200 inch video monitor was settled in another room during 22nd-23rd.

Poster Session:

310 posters were presented. All posters were allowed to expose from 20th to 23rd, and two poster sections were organized on 22nd afternoon (15:50-17:20) and 23rd afternoon (13:35-15:00). The following four poster presentations received the poster award: D. S. Matteson (Washington State University); R. van Benthem (University of Amsterdam); K. Kondo (University of Tokyo); H. Henniges (Georg-August Universität Göttingen).

Opening Ceremony:

The Opening Ceremony opened at 9:00AM

on 20th at the Main Hall of Kobe International Conference Center. S.-I. Murahashi (Chairman of the Organizing Committee, Osaka University) gave the opening address.

T. Tachi (President of Kinki Chemical Society, Kenegafuchi Chemical Co.), K. Morita (Chairman of Finance Committee, Takeda Pharmaceutical Co.), and I. P. Beletskaya (President of the Division of Organic Chemistry, IUPAC, Moscow State University) gave their addresses.

Social Program:

Welcome Get-together was held on Sunday evening at the conference site (free), Reception was held on 20th evening at Hotel Gaufrès Ritz (free), and Banquet was held on 22nd evening at Portopia Hotel. A. Yamamoto (Waseda University) gave an impressive dinner talk.

The organizing committee arranged two excursions. One was visit to Himeji Castle (the national treasure), and the other was visit to Sake Brewery and Kobe Harbor. The organizing committee also arranged the family programs; the lecture of Japanese flower arrangement and tea ceremony (the traditional Japanese villa), Kobe half day tour, and Kyoto full day tour.

Closing Ceremony:

On 23rd, the closing ceremony was held. After the speech of the chairman S.-I. Murahashi, B. Lipshutz gave welcome address

as a chairman of the next OMCOS-8, which was held in Santa Barbara, California. The members of the Ad hoc Committee who actually ran this symposium were introduced. The main conference hall was still full of the participants.




